Do you want to use your VA benefits?

Let the hospital know that you are a veteran with benefits.

Do you have questions about your Health Benefits?

If you are eligible for VA benefits, then the VA encourages you to apply so that enrollment eligibility can be determined. If you served in the active military service, the Reserves, or National Guard, and were separated under any condition other than dishonorable, you may qualify for VA health care benefits.

A volunteer can also assist you with going online to see what benefits you may receive as an enrolled Veteran through the Health benefits Explorer at:

Are you service connected but would like to be reevaluated? If so, we have VA volunteers who can help reconnect you. Our VA Volunteers are equipped with a laptop to assist you with registering for VA benefits online, or by calling the VA to aid the application process.
