Supporting nurses and allied health professionals reflects our mission to care for and respect our patients, their families and each other.

Award Guidelines

Scholarship recipients may receive up to a maximum of \$5,000 (\$2,500 paid for two semesters) to offset the cost of books, uniforms and tuition. Funds are distributed to the institution upon submission and approval of all appropriate invoices and grade reports. Students must maintain an average grade of "C" or better to maintain eligibility.

Scholarship Requirements

- Applicants must be graduates of Ocean City or Mainland Regional high schools.
- Applicants must be matriculated in a Nursing program or other allied health field, such as Radiologic Technology, Sonography, Medical Laboratory Technology, Respiratory Therapy, etc.

Applicant Materials

For consideration by the scholarship selection committee, all applicants must submit the following information:

- Resume highlighting achievements, awards and activities;
- Two (2) letters of recommendation from teachers;
- Transcripts from current school;
- Essay (250-500 words) explaining your desire to enter the healthcare field;
- Letter of acceptance from an accredited College or Allied Health Program
